

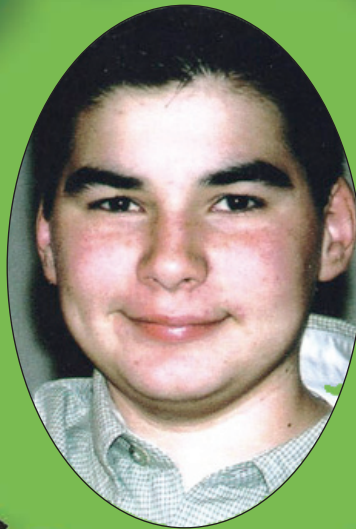

** On February 24, 2005, Jake Clough was injured in a bicycle accident and suffered a brain injury. At the time of his accident Jake was proudly wearing his Lance Armstrong "Livestrong" yellow wrist band, and more importantly, his bike helmet. Because Jake was wearing his bike helmet he survived the accident and the prognosis for a full recovery from head injury was excellent. On Friday, March 18, 2005 (Jake's 15th birthday) he was transferred to Children's Mercy Hospital to begin his rehabilitation program. On March 22, 2005 Jake unexpectedly passed away, though not as a result of his brain injury.

As a tribute to Jake, his parents have established **THE JAKE CLOUGH HEADSTRONG FOUNDATION**, 501 (c) (3), which develops programs promoting bicycle safety and the importance of wearing a properly fitted helmet, as well as programs to benefit others who have been affected by brain injury.
